- Reduced labour needs

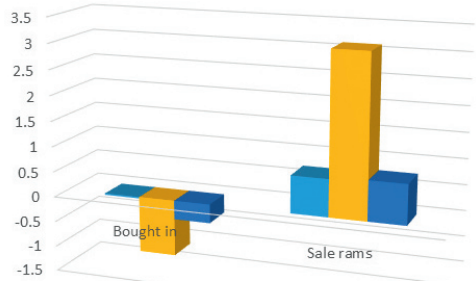
